Vote by Mail

Early Voting by mail will be available for all 2020 elections

Deadline to register to vote and change party enrollment for the General Election:

Saturday, October 24, 2020 – 2:00 – 4:00 PM & 7:00 – 8:00 PM

Deadline to apply for a vote by mail ballot before the General Election:

Wednesday, October 28, 2020 – 5:00 PM

There are two ways to apply for a vote by mail ballot:

Fill out the postcard you received from the Secretary of State's Office and return (you can drop in the mail (postage paid) or drop off at Town Hall)
