

A message to Richmond Registered Voters from the Town Clerk

Regarding the In-Person Early Voting Process:

Registered voters may come to the Town Hall polling location during the scheduled early voting hours. The voter must check in and will be given an early voting ballot and an early voting envelope. The voter will proceed to a voting booth to fill out the ballot. The voter must also complete the affidavit on the early voting envelope then seal the voted ballot in the envelope. Upon completion, the voter will hand the sealed envelope to a poll worker. The sealed envelope will be secured until Election Day when early voting ballots will be cast by a poll worker.

Please keep in mind that during the early voting period certain activities are prohibited within the designated polling location. Restricted activities include cell phone use, public exhibition of campaign materials and public announcement of political support.

During the early voting period Town Hall staff will be working as usual.
